



Completion formalities in Guernsey

Completion by conveyance

The Conveyancing Court sits each Tuesday and Thursday at 9:30am and attendance is required on the agreed completion date. Attendance can be in person or by authorisation through a board resolution or by a power of attorney so as to enable representatives of this firm to appear in the Conveyancing Court on your behalf.

Completion by share transfer

If the transaction is to complete by transfer of the issued shares of the seller company rather than by conveyance, completion will be by way of a meeting of the board of directors on the day of completion.

Court formalities

Please note that if required to attend at court, court guidelines require smart dress and there are also security checks (similar to airports) at the Royal Court entrance.
