# Digital Identification & Verification (ID&V) App <u>Frequently Asked Questions</u>

#### 1. Before using the tool for the first time, can I see a demo of what I will be asked?

Yes, here is a You Tube demo to let you see how easy it is to verify your passport and if required, utility bill for address verification: a video run-through.

# 2. Why is Mourant switching identity verification to ID-Pal?

We know that having a copy of your passport, driving licence or ID card and utility bill, bank statement or government correspondence certified by an acceptable person is a hassle. It also means that your documents are copied on multiple devices (photo copier/printer, email systems, document management systems, etc) to be certified and sent to Mourant electronically. ID-Pal permits you to verify your identity and address at any time using your mobile personal device in less than 3 minutes.

# 3. Is the ID-Pal app safe to use?

Yes, ID-Pal is an Irish based company specialising in digital identity online tools that are secure to use and comply with Mourant's KYC legal requirements and strict information security standards. ID-Pal have ISO- 27001 designation (like Mourant) which is the gold standard for cyber and information security standards.

#### 4. How do I check if the link sent to me in an email is legitimate?

You can validate the link sent to you from Mourant (via an ID-Pal email address) by emailing the Mourant contact you are working with AND copy the relevant team below and they will confirm we have sent the link to you:

#### 5. Where is ID-Pal based?

ID-Pal is based in Ireland and uses a secure EU-based cloud environment that has been certified under ISO-27001, the gold standard in information management and cyber security.

#### 6. Will ID-Pal have access to my identification data?

No, ID-Pal will not be able to see your personal data at any time. ID-Pal is a completely digital tool that runs online identity authentication checks against machine readable data and cross-checks this with independent sources. An example is that ID-Pal can cross-check a passport's size, font and holographic images to determine the document is a validly issued government document. No human intervention or review is conducted by ID-Pal of your identity documents.

# 7. Will ID-Pal store my personal data?

ID-Pal cannot see your personal data at any time. ID-Pal will only hold it for the short period of time that the tool runs the digital authentication checks and produces a pdf report for Mourant to download. That report for Mourant contains a copy of your identity documents and whether the authentication checks were passed or not. Once Mourant downloads the report from ID-Pal's portal, the information is permanently erased from ID-Pal's portal and systems which operate using an EU-based secure cloud. Mourant is the only entity that will hold your personal data on an ongoing basis, in accordance with our KYC obligations.

#### 8. Will my data be accessible or stored in the US?

No. ID-Pal use different sub-processes to electronically validate your identity and address. Some of those sub-processes or databases (depending on where your identify documents originate) may involve US-originated systems. Your data will not be accessible or stored in the US at any time.

#### 9. Does ID-Pal use bio-metric data?

Yes, ID-Pal uses facial recognition to compare your face in the camera to that of your identity document. This means that even with different hair colour, facial hair or glasses, ID-Pal can reliably ensure the photo appearing in the passport (or other acceptable government ID) presented is the same person who is holding it up to the camera. ID-Pal uses the bio-metric data to authenticate your identity but it is not stored by ID-Pal or Mourant.

#### 10. Will Mourant have access to my bio-metric information?

No, Mourant will not have access to your bio-metric data used as part of the ID-Pal digital authentication process. Mourant will receive a pdf report from ID-Pal containing a photo of your identity document and utility bill (or other suitable address document) taken by your phone while using the ID-Pal app and validation in the form of yes/no whether all the digital authentication checks were passed.

### 11. Is there a charge for downloading or using the app?

No, the ID-Pal app is free for you to download and use.

# 12. What if I don't want to use ID-Pal to verify my identity?
